

Employee Health and Safety Program Overview

The Accident Prevention Program (APP) is the foundation of the agency's comprehensive Employee Health & Safety (EH&S) Program. Additional written EH&S Program manuals have been developed to address agency-specific needs which are listed below and shall be made available to all employees and volunteers at every agency facility.

The entire EH&S program meets all federal, state, and local regulatory requirements to ensure safe and healthy workplaces for all agency employees and volunteers statewide.

Workplace hazards throughout the agency are extremely diverse. Each facility and/or park is unique in many ways including different workplace hazards and equipment, and different safety training requirements. The goal is to have a well-trained workforce that knows how to work safely and can help prevent workplace accidents and employee injuries at all agency facilities statewide.

State Parks' APP complies with WAC 296-800-140 as administered and enforced by the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries (L&I).
